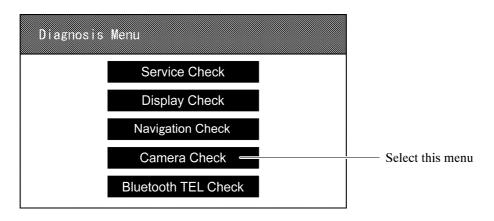
## ■INITIALIZE FUNCTION DUE TO PARTS REPLACEMENT

The initialize function must always be performed whenever one of the conditions indicated in the table below occurs.
